
**MOTION FOR ALTERNATING CHALLENGES AND REQUEST FOR VOIR DIRE**

The State of Maryland, by and through Marilyn J. Mosby, the State’s Attorney for Baltimore City; Michael Schatzow, Chief Deputy State’s Attorney for Baltimore City; Janice L. Bledsoe, Deputy State’s Attorney for Baltimore City, hereby requests, pursuant to Rule 4-313, alternating challenges, and, pursuant to Rule 4-312, that this Court examine the jurors of the array using the Voir Dire that the Court utilized in the trial of *State of Maryland vs. William Porter* (#115141037), along with the following modifications:

1. Amend Question 6 to strike the name “William Porter” and substitute “Caesar Goodson.”
2. Amend Question 7 to strike the names “Joseph Murtha and Gary Proctor” and substitute “Matthew Fraling, Sean Malone, Andrew Graham, and Amy Askew.”
3. Use the attached updated Appendix of Witness during Question 8.
4. Amend Question 14 to read, “Does any member of the panel have strong feelings about the crimes of depraved heart murder, involuntary manslaughter, vehicular manslaughter, assault, reckless endangerment, or police misconduct in office?”
5. Strike Question 16 unless requested by the Defendant. If requested by the Defendant, amend the question to a form inquiring about whether the jurors have “strong feelings” about the race of either the Defendant or the victim.
6. Amend Question 19 to update the anticipated ending date of the trial.
7. Amend Question 27 to read, “Do you have any special knowledge about police procedure?”

Wherefore, the State requests that this Court permit alternating challenges and examine the jurors of the array using the voir dire herein requested.


