MOTION FOR SUMMONS OF OUT OF STATE WITNESS

The Defendant, by undersigned counsel, moves this Honorable Court to issue the attached order, pursuant to MD Code Courts and Judicial Proceedings § 9-303 and Title 42 Pa.C.S.A Judiciary and Judicial Procedure § 5974 (a), certifying that the DONTA ALLEN is material witness in the Defendant's case and that his presence as a witness is required at trial and states in support of:

- That the Defendant is charged with Manslaughter, 2nd Degree Assault,
 Misconduct in Office and Reckless Endangerment as a result of his alleged involvement in the arrest and subsequent death of Freddie Gray.
- 2. That it is alleged that the victim, Freddie Gray, sustained injuries during his transport in a police transport van.
- 3. That the requested witness, Donta Allen, was a passenger in the same transport vehicle as the victim during the ride that allegedly caused Mr. Gray's injuries.
