and felony cases that did not go to trial. New trial dates shall be assigned for misdemeanor cases

by the Criminal Assignment Office of the Circuit Court for Baltimore City. New trial dates for

felony cases shall be assigned by Judge Melissa Phinn, Judge in Charge of the Criminal Docket.
