Administrative Order No. 2020-08

It is **HEREBY ORDERED** this <u>27th</u> day of April, 2020, that counsel may file pleadings and papers with electronic signatures; and it is further

ORDERED that electronic signatures shall be in compliance with Maryland Rule 20-107 requirements for MDEC electronic signatures; and it is further

ORDERED that pursuant to Maryland Rule 20-107, counsel shall provide filer's address, email address, telephone number, and counsel's Client Protection Fund identification number in the pleading or paper.
