WHEREAS it is crucial that Court management and the Baltimore City Sheriff's Office are aware of any law enforcement activity taking place within the Clarence Mitchell Courthouse, the Elijah E. Cummings Courthouse, the Juvenile Justice Center, and any building temporarily used as a Court facility (hereinafter referred to as "Court facilities"); it is this 30th day of June, 2025, hereby

ORDERED that all law enforcement officers entering Court facilities on official business/duty must first report to the Baltimore City Sheriff's Office, which is located in Room 104 of the Clarence Mitchell Courthouse, to identify themselves and identify the purpose of their visit; and it is further

**ORDERED** that all law enforcement officers entering Court facilities on official business/duty must wear their agency's uniform, or, if in plain clothes, must prominently display above the waist their agency's identification card and/or badge.
