## **ORDER**

On June 6, 2016, the Defendant filed Officer Goodson's Motion to Dismiss Based on the State's Violations of Defendant's Constitutional and Discovery Rights. The Defendant also filed a Motion to Seal Officer Goodson's Motion to Dismiss Based on the State's Violations of Defendant's Constitutional and Discovery Rights. UNSEALED.
