MOTION TO WITHDRAW DEFENSE MOTION IN LIMINE PRECLUDING REFERENCE TO OR ARGUMENT ABOUT THE LEGALITY OF THE KNIFE RECOVERED FROM MR. GRAY IN THE COURSE OF HIS DETENTION AND ARREST

Defendant, Officer Garrett Miller, by undersigned counsel, files this Motion to Withdraw a previously filed Motion in Limine requesting the Court to order the preclusion of any and all reference to or argument regarding the legality of the knife recovered from Mr. Gray in the course of his detention or arrest. In support, Defendant states the following:

- On February 12, 2016 Officer Garrett Miller, through counsel, filed a
 Motion in Limine requesting the exclusion of evidence or argument
 regarding the legality of a spring-assisted knife recovered from the
 decedent, Mr. Freddie Gray.
- Based on the evidence and arguments presented by the State in State v.
 Nero, Case No. 115141033, counsel seeks to introduce evidence regarding both the recovery and legality of the weapon seized from Mr. Gray.

3. The Defense moves to withdraw the previously filed Motion in Limine, without prejudice.

WHEREFORE Defendant Officer Garrett Miller respectfully requests this Honorable Court to allow counsel to withdraw the defense request to order the preclusion of any and all reference to or argument regarding the legality of the knife recovered from Mr. Gray in the course of his detention or arrest.
