MOTION FOR SUMMONS OF OUT OF STATE WITNESS

The Defendant, by undersigned counsel, moves this Honorable Court to issue the attached order, pursuant to MD Code Courts and Judicial Proceedings § 9-303 and Title 42 Pa.C.S.A Judiciary and Judicial Procedure § 5974 (a), certifying that DONTA ALLEN is a material witness in the Defendant's case and that his presence as a witness is required at trial and states in support of:

- 1. That the Defendant is charged with Manslaughter, 2nd Degree Assault, Misconduct in Office and Reckless Endangerment as a result of his alleged involvement in the arrest and subsequent death of Freddie Gray.
- 2. That it is alleged that the victim, Freddie Gray, sustained injuries during his transport in a police transport van.
- 3. That the requested witness, Donta Allen, was a passenger in the same transport vehicle as the victim during the ride that allegedly caused Mr. Gray's injuries.
- 4. That the requested witness, Donta Allen, gave statements to police investigators regarding his observation of Mr. Gray's actions during the transportation.
- 5. That the requested witness' observations of Mr. Gray during his transportation and his subsequent statements to investigators regarding those observations make him a material witness in this matter.
- 6. That the requested witness is currently being held in York County Prison in York,
 Pennsylvania and his offender number is 213834.
- 7. That the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania allows that upon certification by a judge of another state court that a person confined within the Commonwealth who may be a material witness in a criminal proceeding and whose presence will be required during a specified time a court

having jurisdiction over the person confined and upon notice to the Bureau of Correction, the court shall fix a time and place for a hearing and shall make an order directed to the person having custody of the prisoner requiring that the prisoner be produced before it at the hearing. 42 Pa.C.S.A. § 5974.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant respectfully requests that this court grant the attached order certifying that Mr. Donta Allen is a material witness in this matter and that his presence is required for trial so that the certification can be presented to the District Court/Court of Common Pleas for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, County of York in order for a hearing to be granted to request an order directing the York County Prison to produce Mr. Donta Allen, ID # 213834 on or before November 30, 2015 and every day following until a verdict or a judgment has been reached in this matter.
