ORDER

On October 14, 2015, this Court ordered the State to turn over documents relating to their independent investigation into the death of Freddie Gray, up to and ending May 1, 2015.

On November 9, 2015, the State filed the State's Motion for Appropriate Relief Under Seal. The State asked this Court to review documents generated by the State's Attorney's Office during this time frame that it believes are outside the scope of its independent investigation and therefore, the State should not be required to disclose. On November 12, 2015, Defendant filed the Defendant's Response in Opposition to the State's Motion for Appropriate Relief.

This Court has reviewed the disputed documents, and in consideration of the motions and responses, it is this 16 day of November, 2015 hereby

ORDERED that the State disclose the following documents: A11 through A13; A24 through A27; A28 through A30; A44 through A45; B9 through B10; B12 through B15.5 ("100-Day Accomplishments"); B18.5 ("Recent Baltimore Sun Articles") through B40; B47; B48 through B55; B56 through B58.5 ("100-Day Accomplishments"); B61.5 ("Recent Baltimore Sun Articles") through B83; B84 through B92.
