ORDER

On June 10, 2016, this Court found that the State had violated Maryland Rule 4-263 by failing to turn over exculpatory material and ordered the State to turn over all discovery that could be considered exculpatory in the above-captioned case.

On June 13, 2016, the State submitted documents for this Court for in camera review. The State asked this Court to either not require the State to turn over certain documents, or to redact other documents.

In an Order dated June 16, 2016, this Court ordered the State to turn over the documents and sealed the Order until such time as the proceedings for this case and related cases were concluded. This Court notes that the disputed documents were returned to the State upon completion of the in camera review. These cases now having concluded, it is this 3rd day of August, 2016 hereby
