**ORDER**

On June 10, 2016, this Court found that the State had violated Maryland Rule 4-263 by failing to turn over exculpatory material and ordered the State to turn over all discovery that could be considered exculpatory in the above-captioned case.

On June 13, 2016, the State submitted documents for this Court for in camera review. The State asked this Court to either not require the State to turn over certain documents, or to redact other documents.

This Court reviewed the documents, and finds that it is appropriate to turn them over. Therefore, it is this 16<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2016 hereby

**ORDERED** that the State disclose all documents submitted to this Court on June 13, 2016 for in camera review, including text messages between Deputy State's Attorney Janice Bledsoe and Detective Dawnyell Taylor; text messages between Assistant State's Attorney Albert Peisinger and Detective Dawnyell Taylor; Detective Dawnyell Taylor's investigatory notes into the death of Freddie Gray; a letter submitted from the State's Attorney's Office to the Baltimore City Police Department;

and the response letter from the Baltimore City Police Department to the State's Attorney's Office; and further

**ORDERED** that these documents shall be turned over in unredacted form; and further

**ORDERED** that the contents of these documents shall not be disclosed to any person outside of the immediate trial team; and further

**ORDERED** that the documents, and their contents, are not to be used by the Defense, unless or until this Court orders it; and further

**ORDERED** that this Order be **SEALED**.
